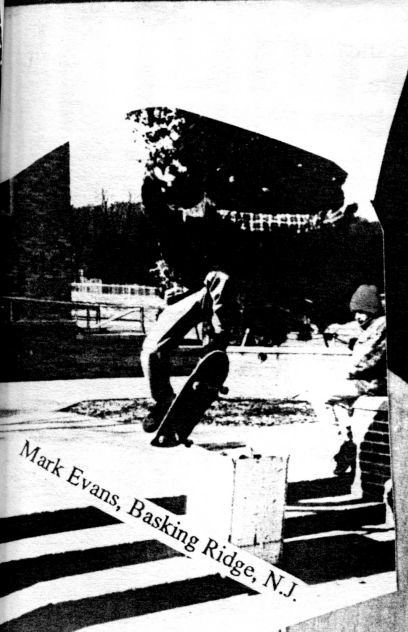

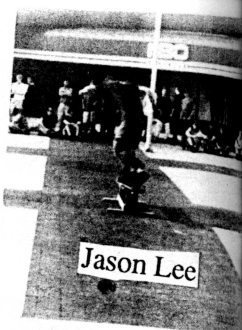

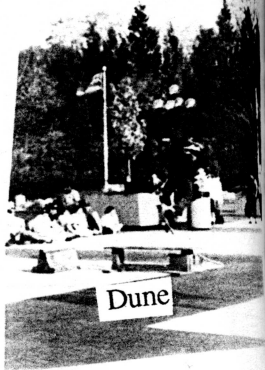
Review of...

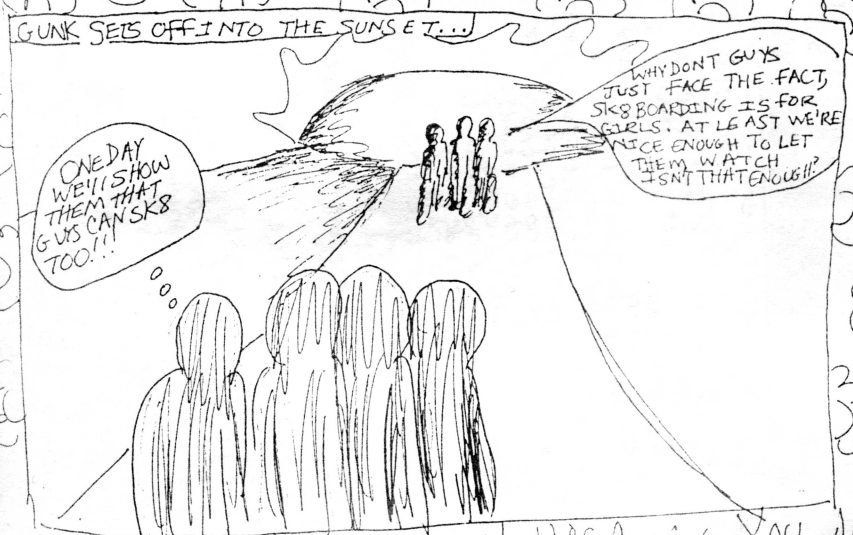
